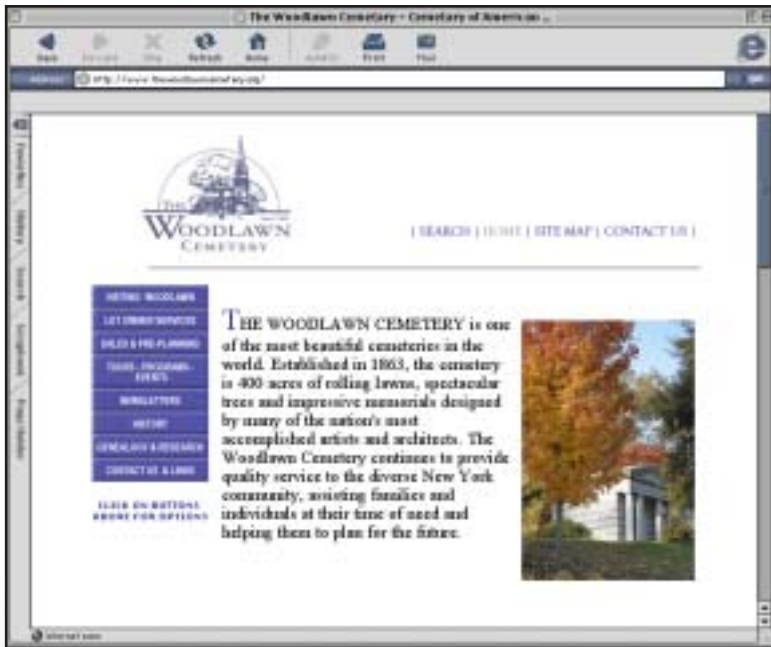


WOODLAWN ON THE WORLD WIDE WEB

MEMORIAL DAY EVENTS

The Woodlawn Cemetery will honor those who served our country by placing flags on the graves of the Veterans in our care on Memorial Day weekend. On Saturday, May 29th, volunteers will help put the flags out in the cemetery. We will start at 9 a.m. from the Jerome Gatehouse. Volunteers will be provided with location maps and flags and will be treated to a picnic lunch at the Jerome Gatehouse when the work is complete.

On Sunday, May 30th at 2 p.m., the Roster of Veterans will be read at the Woolworth Chapel. Community leaders, Scouts and Family members of our Veterans will be invited to take part in the reading of several hundred names. The name of the Veteran, Rank and Branch of Service will be read. If the Veteran served in time of war, the war will be announced with the Veteran's name.

Our burial records of the past do not indicate if an individual was a Veteran and many of the grave markers do not indicate that a Veteran is buried in the lot. If you have information about a Veteran in Woodlawn's care or would like to volunteer to help place flags on the Veteran's graves, please call the Friends office to add the name of a Veteran to our roster (718) 920-1470.
